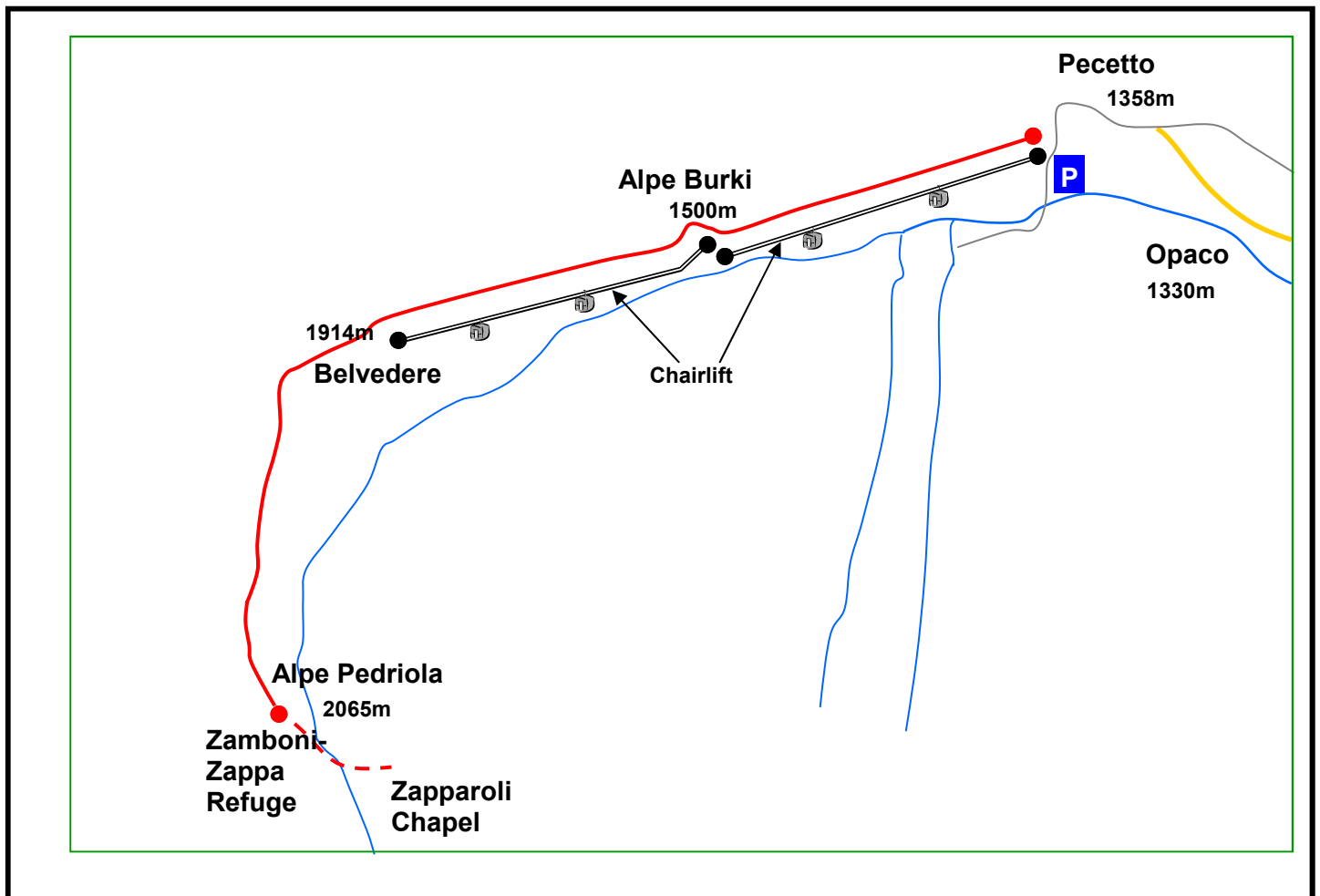


Itinerary: Macugnaga / Belvedere Glacier & Zamboni Refuge



Practical Info

- Main road
- Minor road
- Walking route

Depart from: Pecetto (1358m)
Height difference: 707m
Time: 2 hours
Difficulty: T (Tourist) - Route extension T (Tourist)

Itinerary

1. Drive through Staffa to Pecetto and park at the chairlift station
 2. From the chairlift station there is a wide path that roughly follows the route of the chairlift
 3. It climbs slowly with a couple of long turns (this is a ski run during the winter) before it reaches the Alpe Burki chairlift station and the surrounding pasture
 4. To the left of the chairlift station the route makes a couple of turns then there is a steep ascent with lots of turns which runs under the chairlift before reaching Belvedere
 5. The path continues to the left and just after a small wooden building you reach the edge of the glacier
 6. You cross the glacier following the painted signs
 7. Following the path further you reach a fork and go to the left and after leaving the side of the glacier you arrive in the Pedriola Valley
 8. Cross the stream and follow the old mule path to the Zamboni-Zappa Refuge
 9. The routes around Monte Rosa are well signed
 10. For a shorter walk you can use the chairlifts in either direction
- There are bars at the chairlift stations
